p. 38 **Austin**

- (1) A diminutive of Augustine (Majestic) the name of the great Father of the Church. Augustinus of Hippo, and his namesake the first Archbishop of Canterbury.
- (2) an Englishman of Uisdean (Hinisdean) One of the many instances in which classic names are utilized to represent Gaelic names of a somewhat similar sound.

“The Austin’s appear first on record as allies and supporters of the Keiths. The name was variously spelt, though in ancient records it was generally begun with Ou or Ow. Of curious interest as shown an early connection between the families of Alexander Ousteane, Burgess of Edinburgh, as one of the cautioners (one who stands) for George Keith, Earl of Marshall, in an action raised surety for another

against him by Margaret Erskine, Lady Pitcarie. In the same year Alexander Ousteane no doubt the same person, was a parliamentary representative of the Burgh of Edinburgh. In 1589 Walter Oustene, a tenant in Lockgahan (a possession of the Keath Family, was one of the subscribers to a Bond of Caution imposed on a number of the landed men in the shires of Aberdeen and Kincardine, binding them to keep the peace in the struggles with the Catholic party headed by Huntly. (D. W. Stewart, *Old and Rare Scottish Tartans*) The Austins of the parish of Fettercairn are said to be of English descent and there during the 17th century (Cameron, *History of Fettercairn*, p. 226) John Owstyn was a tenant of Earl of Douglas in the barony of Preston, 1376 (R. H. M. (*Registrum Honoris de Mortem*) p. 1xi) Andrew Austin was prior of Dunfermline, 1448 (R. D. p. 309) *Registrum de Dunfermelyn - - Edinburgh 1542*

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and in 1503 David Ostien was prebend of Holy Trinity, Edinburgh (Soltra, p. 158). John Oustiane was burgess of Edinburgh 1566 (RRPC., I, p. 447) Alexander Oustiane deacon of the southwest quarter of the burgh in 1574 (MCM, I, p. 107). *Maul/Matl and ClerkClub Miscellany*.

And Alexander Austene tailor there in 1594 (E.R. XXII, p. 582). *The Exchequer rolls of Scotland*.

Mary Austine is recorded at Grangeburn 1676 (*Kirkcudbright*).

Agnes Owstine in Reidcastle, 1681 (*Dumfries*), William Oustine of Kirkland, 1699 (*Inquir. 8109*), and Agnes Austine Deanstown 1755. *Austeane 1593, Oistiane 1583, Ostiane 1584, Austein, Ostian, Oustian*.

This book gives an extract from the Journal of Congress, dated Sept. 16, 1776
The Balloting Book and Other Documents Relating to Military Bounty Lands in the State of New York

“That Congress make provision for granting lands in the following proportions to the officers and soldiers who shall so engage in the service, and continue therein to the close of the war, or until discharged by Congress, and to the representatives of such officers and soldiers as shall be slain by the enemy.

Such lands to be provided by the U. S. and whatever expense shall be necessary to procure such land, the said expense shall be paid and borne by the states, in the same proportion as the other expenses of the war; viz:”

To a Colonel	500 acres
For a Lieutenant Colonel	450 acres
To a Major	400 acres
To a Captain	300 acres
To a Lieutenant	200 acres
To an Ensign	150 acres
Each non-commissioned Officer and soldier	100 acres

Later in 1783 the State of New York in addition to the above grants granted every non-commissioned officer and private 500 acres each.

Claims were to be “exhibited on or before the first day of January, 1791 – to lands set apart for the Troops of The Line of this State, lately serving in the Army of the U. S. Records were kept in the Surveyor General’s Office.

The Austin Family in America

Austins were numerous in New England in the first colonial century. All the pioneers were of English origin. There were various spellings of the name, but probably all were of the same family originally. In early records the surnames appears as Asten, Astin, Astine, Astring, Aston, Austen, Auston, Astone, and Oston.

Anthony Austin of Rowley, Mass., was a freeman in 1669 and afterwards was in Suffield, Conn. He died in 1708. His children were Richard, b. 1666; Anthony, b. 1668; John, born 1672; Nathaniel, born 1678; Elizabeth, born 1681; and Esther, b. 1686. His descendants have been many.

Francis Austin was first of Dedham and afterwards of Hampton, Mass., in 1648. By his wife, Isabelle, he had two daughters, Jemima and Sophia.

John Austin was of New London, Conn. in 1647, in Greenwich after 1651, and later in Stamford. He died in Stamford Aug. 25, 1657, leaving a widow, Catherine Austin, son, Samuel, and daughter Elizabeth, who married Joseph Finch, and perhaps a son, John.

John Austin of New Haven, Conn., married first Nov. 5, 1667 Mercy Atwater, daughter of Joseph Atwater. His children were: John, b. Apr. 23, 1669; David, born Feb. 23, 1671; Joshua, b. Sept. 3, 1673; Mary; John and Hannah twins, born Oct. 14, 1677; Mercy, b. Apr. 17, 1680; a son born Apr. 5, 1683 and died within a few days. His wife died in Apr. 1863, and he married,

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second, Jan. 21, 1685 Elizabeth Brackett, by whom he had Sarah, b. Jan. 23, 1686, and Elizabeth, b. in 1687. He died in 1690 and his widow died before 1695.

John Austin of Scarborough, ME was more commonly known as John Ashton, although it is not certainly known that the two were identical. He married a daughter of Andrew Alger and was of Marblehead, MA in 1675.

John Austin came to America in the ship Hercules from Tenterden, Eng. John Austin, the mayor of Tenterden at that time, was probably his father. With him came his wife, Contance[Constance?] Austin. He settled first in Cambridge, MA, then called Newton. Was in Hingham, MA in 1635 and in Taunton MA in 1643. He died in Taunton July 30, 1683. With other children he left a son, Jonah Austin of Taunton.

Joseph Austin, of Hampton, MA 1642 and Dover 1648 died in 1663. His second wife, whom he married in 1659, was Sarah (Starbuck) Storey, daughter of Edward

Starbuck and widow of William Story. He left a son, Thomas, and other children.

Leonard Austin of New Haven, brother of John Austin of New Haven, was a weaver and died in 1678.

Matthew Austin of York, ME was killed by the Indians about 1704.

Richard Austin came from Southampton, England, in the ship Bevis in 1638 with his wife and two children. He settled in Charlestown, MA. He had lived in Bishopstoke, county Hants.

Robert Austin was the founder of the family in Rhode Island. Little is known concerning him. His home was in Kings Town, and in 1661 his name appears on a

list of persons to whom land was granted. Probably he died before 1687, as his name does not appear on the tax list of that year. Sons: Jeremiah, Edward, Joseph, and John. {Some of this man's descendants lie in the Blanchard Cemetery, Otsego Co., NY.}

Samuel Austin was of Dover, NH in 1649 and afterwards of Wells, ME, being a representative to the general court in 1682.

John Austin, born in London, England and there trained as a merchant by his father, came to Boston and subsequently removed to Hartford CN. He married in Hartford Dec. 8, 1713. Mary (Stanley) Hooker, widow. He died in Hartford in 1743, and his widow Mary died Aug 23, 1756 aged 76. He had a son John, born Oct. 15, 1714, died young, and a daughter Mary, who married John Ellery of Boston.

John Austin – sometimes called John Astin – was in Philadelphia in 1683, receiving on Nov. 1 of that year a patent of confirmation of a lot of ground. Part of this land he sold in Aug. 1686, and in the deed he is styled “Of the Town and County of Philadelphia, ship carpenter.” In a later deed, Aug. 4, 1687, he is styled “ship carpenter of the County Bucks.” He married Nov. 11, 1686, by Friends ceremony, Jane Potts of Philadelphia and probably removed to Bucks county soon after. He returned to Philadelphia in a few years and followed the business of ship-wright, having a yard on the banks of the Delaware River. He died before February 25, 1708, that being the date of the granting of administration on his estate.

They kept at the old store, and Mr. Haggerty resided over it until 1809, when he removed his residence to 69 Pine. Haggerty and Austin kept on at 169 Pearl until after the war, when their store was changed into 167 Pearl, and there they remained while in business...

I think about 1833 the house of Haggerty and Austin and Co. was the largest auction house in the city, if not in the world...

In the firm of Haggerty, Austin, and Co. David Austin held the commission. That year the duties laid by David Austin were \$52,244.82.

The concern could handle anything in a financial way. If an East India house had tea or silks worth \$2,000,000 Haggerty

Austin and Co. could advance all that he needed and draw a single check for a million if it was required.

The house of Austin and Haggerty continued as dry goods jobbers until 1822. After they went into the auction business, a great contest commenced as to which house should pay the highest auction duties in the state. J. and P. Hone were at first rivals, but in ten years all were distanced, and in 1833 the Hones paid only \$4,000, when Haggerty Austin and Co. paid \$52,000 as I have stated. It was a difficult thing in those days to get an auctioneer's commission, unless the person applying belonged to the party in power in the State, then Democratic.

David Austin was the Democratic partner of Haggerty and Austin. He married the sister of Mr. Haggerty.

I think the house of Haggerty and Austin dissolved in 1833.

After the above company was dissolved David went into partnership with Spicer. They failed.
