1. **Cornelius Austin Case 14 CHEROKEE FREEDMAN** was born about 1866 in Indian Territory, Oklahoma. Cornelius was a minister of the United Methodist Episcopal Church in Muskogee County, Oklahoma in 1920. His father was Thomas Austin. His mother was probably Eliza Fountaine, according to the Dawes Card #F715. Cornelius might have married twice.

Austin, Cornelius N., head, male, black, 49, married, OK, VA, OK, Minister U.M.E. church; Carrie L., wife, F, Mulatto 28, married, TX, TX, TX, dressmaker; Cornelius N., Jr. son male, black, 5, OK, OK, TX. It is not known if this Cornelius is the same person as the Cherokee Freedman Dawes Card F715.

Cornelius married **Mary** . Mary was born in 1876 in Indian Territory. Her father was probably Nelson Moore and her mother was probably Rase Moore, according to the Dawes Card.

More research after November 2010 needs to be done for Thomas Austin and his son Cornelius.
