A recent article¹ covered the Solomon and Clarinda (Richardson) Millington family of Rutland County, Vermont, and Illinois. Two of their sons Daniel Azro Millington and Samuel Churchill Millington, who settled respectively in Cowley and Crawford Counties, Kansas, were introduced. Later generations of this family are covered in this typescript.

Rachel Ann Nixon, a granddaughter of Daniel Azro Millington, contributed material to Robert W. Tirrell. His unevenly documented collection of Millington data at the New England Historic Genealogical Society contains extensive correspondence from the 1920s into the 1940s, abstracts of deeds, numerous single sheets arranged alphabetically by first name of Millington descendants, and several other miscellaneous items.²

Another distantly related Millington family also settled in eastern Kansas after dwelling in McDonough County, Illinois, during the nineteenth century.³
