

1. SOLOMON⁵ MILLINGTON (*Solomon*⁴, *Samuel*³, *John*²⁻¹) was born in Rutland County, Vermont, on 24 February 1797, and died at Fairbury, Illinois, on 17 December 1868. He married CLARINDA RICHARDSON, born at Hubbardton, Vermont, on 6 June 1800 and died on 24 October 1854.¹ He married second ELIZA SMITH,² who was born in Vermont ca. 1806. Solomon was enumerated in Plainfield, Illinois, in 1850;³ some of his children were doubly enumerated that year in the household of his son Samuel.⁴ He was almost certainly the Solomon Melengton, a 63-year-old farmer, enumerated in Lenawee County, Michigan, in 1860.⁵

2. DANIEL AZRO⁶ MILLINGTON (*Solomon*⁵⁻⁴, *Samuel*³, *John*²⁻¹) was born at Hubbardton, 16 May 1823 and died at Winfield, Kansas, 7 May 1891.¹⁹ He married at Will County, Illinois, 16 May 1848, MARY ANN SMITH, who was born at Waterbury, Vermont, 8 October 1826 and died at Winfield, Kansas, 30 March 1910, daughter of John and Mary Prentice (Calkins) Smith, and a descendant of William Brewster, a passenger on the *Mayflower*.²⁰ Mary lived with her oldest daughter in California in 1900.

"Having come to the conclusion that I could not make money fast enough in Illinois, my adopted (home), I concluded to start for the famous land of gold, California. I made preparation for the journey and started on Monday morning, March 4th, 1850, on horseback."²¹ D. A. Millington, a 28-year-old miner, was enumerated in California in 1850.²²

Leaving his wife and daughter, Millington went by way of St. Louis, St. Joseph, and Salt Lake City. He reached Sacramento, California, 19 July 19 1850. He met with some success in gold mining. On 1 September 1851 he boarded a steamship to return home. On 19 September he disembarked to walk, or ride a mule, across the Isthmus of Panama. Six days later he boarded another steamship in the Atlantic.

Daniel received an education in the common and higher schools of Vermont being proficient in math and science. Taught for five winters and at age 21 moved to Will County, Illinois, where he married. In 1850 he went to California and returned in 1852 to Joliet where he went into the lumber business. In 1856 he went to Iowa City, Iowa, in the general mercantile business. In 1862 he moved to Leavenworth, Kansas, in the same business which was very successful during the war. In January 1866 moved to St. Louis, same business but met with heavy losses. In 1868 moved to Fort Scott Kansas, same business, 1870 closed business and moved to Cowley County on 16 August, where he entered a plan for Winfield. The land had belonged to the Osage Indians who were present in great numbers and the land had not been surveyed. D. A. bought a claim, associated with others who laid out a town, and invited settlers to improve the lots. By 1871 all that work was completed and Winfield was officially a town. He was mayor of Winfield 1875–76,²³ editor/owner of *Courier*, postmaster, and at his death was connected with the Winfield Gas Company. (LWW)

3. SAMUEL CHURCHILL⁶ MILLINGTON (*Solomon*⁵⁻⁴, *Samuel*³, *John*²⁻¹) was born at (probably Hubbardton) Vermont 3 January 1825⁶⁹ and died at Kansas City, Missouri, 9 September 1889.⁷⁰ He married first at Sudbury, Vermont, 24 December 1845, MARY ANN HOWLAND who was born at Pittsford, Vermont, 16 October 1827 and died presumably in McDonough County, Illinois, 14 August 1869, buried in the South Cemetery, Blandinsville, Illinois,⁷¹ daughter of Charles and Harriet (Peck) Howland.⁷² Samuel C. Millington married second at McDonough County, Illinois, 23 December 1869, Mrs. JULIA A. (KIRK) KANE, who was born in Kentucky, ca. 1826–28.⁷³

He was probably the S. C. Millington who was a member of *The Rutland California Company*, whose constitution was signed 25 February 1849.⁷⁴ In 1850 he was a farmer, in 1860 a Methodist clergyman, in 1870 a book dealer, and in 1880, a farmer.⁷⁵ In 1881 he was a member of the Kansas House of Representatives.⁷⁶
